Pie Auction Rules

All pies will be auctioned to benefit *Preserving the Nature of Lummi Island*. Entries can be from individuals or teams (families, co-workers, neighborhoods, organizations, etc.).

- Each pie entry must have a name.
- Each pie must be in a disposable pie pan or one you don't want returned. Let us know if you need a pan.
- NO pies that require refrigeration (No cream toppings or fillings, custard fillings, or high egg content pies, such as pumpkin pie, pecan pie, meringue pie, or cheesecakes). These rules are dictated by the way we get our permit from the health department. More information on food safety regarding pies can be found on [the USDA website](#).

Pie bakers must submit an entry form to Lummi Island Heritage Trust by June 28th. The Heritage Trust will post a list of ingredients by each entry for individuals with food allergies and special diets. Please list ALL of your ingredients on the entry form (quantities are not necessary).

the day of the event Saturday, July 13th by 11:30am.**
